1.00 <u>This Schedule</u>

- 1.01 This Schedule is established between the Parties pursuant to the Master Agreement with respect to [___]'s (the "Recipient") participation in Environmental Assessment-related engagement activities related to the [_] Project (the "Project").
- 1.02 This Schedule will enter into effect on the date of its signature by the Parties and will remain effective until six (6) months after the Minister's Environmental Assessment decision relating to the Environmental Assessment Report or the Review Panel Report of the above referenced proposed Project has been posted on the Canadian Environmental Assessment Registry's Internet site, or thirty (30) days after the termination of the Environmental Assessment–related engagement activities, or the termination of the Environmental Assessment of the above referenced proposed Project as referred to in subsection 8.01 of the Master Agreement, whichever first occurs.
- 1.03 Subject to section 5.00 of the Master Agreement, the Agency will make a Maximum Contribution to the Recipient of **[]** dollars (**\$[]**) for the **[]**. The funding is conditional on satisfaction of all payment conditions set out in section 6.00 of the Master Agreement and further set out herein.
- 1.04 Official Languages: It is agreed that there is no Official Languages requirement for this Schedule as the clientele involved in each Participation Opportunity uses only one of the Official Languages.
- 1.05 Subject to section 6.00 of the Master Agreement, the Recipient will provide a Detailed Financial Report to the Manager for reimbursement of Eligible Costs as an interim or final payment for each Participation Opportunity as set out in the Approved Work Plan and Budget set out in this Schedule. The Detailed Financial Report may contain:
 - (a) a written request for a payment;

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(b) an itemized statement of all Eligible Costs incurred by the Recipient;

- (c) written justification or rationale for any over expenditures with a variance of more than twenty (20) per cent in any expense category of a Participation Opportunity identified in this Schedule;
- (d) originals or photocopies of invoices or receipts accounting for all Eligible Costs incurred by the Recipient;
- (e) an itemized list of all assets referred to in subsection 11.01 of the Master Agreement; and
- (f) an audited financial statement, if such statement is demanded under subsection 6.05 of the Master Agreement.

¹ The Staff Salaries category includes salaries and up to twenty (20) per cent in benefits of the salary amount requested of individuals employed for the purpose of researching and preparing materials related to the participation of the Recipient, providing that:

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if the individual is in receipt of a salary from the Recipient, that the funds are designated temporarily to cover the costs of replacing the individual, so he/she can work full-time on activities related to the Recipient's participation; or

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the individual is not currently in receipt of a salary from the Recipient; or

if the individual is already in receipt of a salary from the Recipient, the funds are designated solely to cover time the individual dedicates to the participation in the environmental assessment or associated crown consultation activities. The individual cannot be in receipt of any other salary or direct income for the time for which salary funding from the Agency is claimed.
