## 2020–21 Departmental Sustainable Development Strategy

## 1. Context for the Departmental Sustainable Development Strategy

Although the Office of the Intelligence Commissioner is not bound by the <u>Federal Sustainable Development</u> <u>Act</u> and is not required to develop a full departmental sustainable development strategy, the Office of the Intelligence Commissioner adheres to the principles of the Federal Sustainable Development Strategy (FSDS) by implementing the *Policy on Green Procurement*.
